Accepted information at face value

Many QN represented schools have very similar names/locations

tried our best to match school identified by QN teacher

Organized information by Centers

School-wide Student Demographics

Across centers considerable variation

- Urban, rural, and suburban schools
- Most often public schools; a few private schools
- Student enrollment size: varied small to large
- Well-balanced by gender of students
- Students eligible for free/reduced lunch
- Student ethnicity
