- If you have a slow connection or not-so-fast wifi, you may need to turn off your video feed by clicking on the *video mute* icon at the top of the window. It looks like this:



- It's good etiquette to mute your microphone while you aren't speaking by clicking on the *audio mute* icon at the top of the window. It looks like this:
